

Bandaged Bear Grand Prix Frequently Asked Questions FAQs

What is the Bandaged Bear Grand Prix?

This year, partnering with Western Earthmoving, we are introducing our first ever Bandaged Bear Grand Prix at Luddenham Raceway. This event is geared towards our motoring enthusiasts where we want you to enjoy go-karting with your team, your work colleagues, your family, your mates all whilst shining a light on kids health.

What does my registration fee cover?

Your registration to this new event will involve your go-karting session, a balaclava, race licence and 1 meal & drink voucher from our catering partner Outback Steakhouse.

What other activities will there be?

Along with your ticket to go-karting, we will be offering additional opportunities to purchase, such as drifting, hot laps in performance vehicles, silent auction, raffle, food trucks. We will also have opportunities to view some car displays throughout the afternoon.

Please note; these additional opportunities will have costs involved.

What will the funds raised for this event be directed towards?

All funds raised through this event will go towards the area of greatest need within the Sydney Children's Hospitals Network. Your support will help us to shine a light on kids health, funding the very latest medical equipment, lifesaving research and essential services for sick kids and their families.

How do I purchase a ticket?

You can purchase your tickets on our event page.

Can I bring my child along?

Whilst children are always welcome to attend the day, they unfortunately will not be able to participate in any of the driving activities.

Please note; all children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

What should I wear?

Please ensure you wear closed in footwear (sneakers or similar) and no loose or flowing clothing, eg. Scarves, long dresses or cardigans.

Is membership/a licence required to drive a go-kart?

You will need to provide a licence and/or photo identification for registration purposes and you will be provided with a Luddenham Raceway licence which will be all you need for our event and is valid for 12 months, so you can visit Luddenham again throughout the year.



Can I bring food/drinks to this event?

You will not need to bring any food or drinks with you to this event as your entry price includes a drink and food voucher from our food partners Outback Steakhouse. You can of course purchase more food/drinks if you wish on the day. Please note; this event is an alcohol free event.

What happens in wet weather?

Luddenham Raceway is an outdoor venue, so please come prepared with appropriate attire. In the event of light rain, the event will still go ahead, however, in extreme weather conditions, the event will be postponed to another date and all registrants will be contacted by 9am Friday 25 June by a Sydney Children's Hospitals Foundation staff member.

Can I bring my own helmet?

You can bring your own helmet as long as they have the Australian Standards Stickers on them and the helmet is not damaged in any way.

Can I bring a go-pro and/or recording device?

Yes you can, however we do ask that all footage is shared with Luddenham Raceway prior to any publication.

Do I need to wear gloves?

Yes, you will need gloves for driving. You can bring your own or gloves can be purchased at the Raceway.

What measures are you taking to ensure a COVID safe event?

Your safety is our priority and we take our responsibility to you, our volunteers and our staff seriously.

To ensure we provide a COVID safe event while still raising much needed funds for The Children's Hospital at Westmead we will be implementing the following procedures and precautions;

- Constant monitoring of the Covid-19 situation and restrictions in place.
- COVIDsafe plan approved by the relevant federal, state and local health authorities.
- QR code check in at the venue.
- Appointed Covid safety marshals in place.
- We encourage all participants to download the Australian Government Covid-19 app on their own device.
- Hand sanitiser will be readily available around the venue.
- If we are unable to hold the physical event due to the ever-changing Covid climate we will postpone the event to a future date. Participants will be kept informed of any modifications to the event.
- If the physical event is unable to proceed due to Covid your registration will automatically be transferred to the next event date. Refunds will only be processed upon request.
